### Explanation of concepts and terms used

**Beneficiary country** (partner country) – country receiving international assistance.

**Civil society organisations** – organisations that include all forms of public action by individuals or associations of individuals who are not linked to the State and are not run by State institutions. A civil society organisation is an organisational body whose members serve a common interest through a democratic process and which plays an intermediary role between public authorities and citizens.

#### I. Summary of the Plan

The Plan is designed to contribute to the implementation of Latvia's development cooperation priorities. The Plan includes concrete measures to contribute to the achievement of the Latvian Development Cooperation Policy objective set out in the Guidelines "to promote sustainable development and poverty eradication, the rule of law and good governance in developing countries, in particular in Latvia's priority partner countries, by contributing to the implementation of Agenda 2030" through development cooperation in the areas of rule of law, public administration development and capacity building, business development, gender equality, promotion of democratic participation and civil society development, education, climate change and environmental protection. The Plan strengthens Latvia's role as a bilateral donor and pursues Latvia's foreign policy interests, as set out in the annual report of the Minister of Foreign Affairs to the Saeima on the country's foreign policy achievements and intentions.

The Plan has been developed at a time when Russia is continuing its full-scale military aggression against Ukraine, launched on 24 February 2022, killing Ukrainian civilians, destroying its infrastructure and damaging its economy. As the world deals with the consequences of the global pandemic of the Covid-19 virus, Russia's actions have deepened existing security and stability challenges and created new ones, including the threat of a global food crisis and disruption of energy supplies. At the same time, the complicity of Belarus in the aggression against Ukraine continues, as does the repression of Belarusian civil society and media by the regime of Alexander Lukashenko. The need to strengthen the rules-based world order continues to grow. Latvia's candidacy for a non-permanent member on the UN Security Council in the 2025 elections for 2026–2027 and its potential election will provide additional opportunities to influence global processes. The challenges to be addressed through the implementation of the UN Agenda 2030 SDGs also remain on the agenda of the international community.

According to the Guidelines, the main thematic priorities of Latvian development cooperation are aligned with the SDGs. SDG 16 Peace, justice, and strong institutions, SDG 5 Gender equality, SDG 4 Quality education, SDG 8 Decent work and economic growth, SDG 13 Climate action and SDG 17 Partnerships for the goals are identified as priorities.

In implementing the thematic priorities, Latvia pays particular attention to digitalisation as an enabler of development and supports innovative and proven digital solutions that can contribute to the efficiency of public administration, public participation in decision-making and the creation of new economic opportunities.

Latvia's thematic priorities for development cooperation also include Latvia's candidacy for a non-permanent member on the UN Security Council in the 2025 elections for the period 2026–2027: rule of law, democracy, good governance, media freedom, resilience to disinformation; women's empowerment, "Women, Peace and Security"; digital issues for development and security; sustainable development; environment and climate.

In light of geopolitical changes, the EU's Eastern Partnership countries (notably Ukraine, Moldova and Georgia, as well as support to Belarusian civil society and independent media) and Central Asian countries (notably Kyrgyzstan, Tajikistan and Uzbekistan) retain their importance as geographical priorities. As Latvian Development Cooperation Policy capacity increases, Latvia is prioritising extending its support to other regions, particularly in Africa, contributing to global public goods and addressing global challenges, which have been further exacerbated by Russia's full-scale military aggression against Ukraine. Latvia is committed to its development cooperation policy commitments to support LDCs as well.

Since 2022, when Russia launched a full-scale military aggression against Ukraine, Latvia has made the development of the assistance and support system in Ukraine, as well as support for victims of Russian military aggression, a priority for development cooperation.

With the granting of EU candidate status to Ukraine and Moldova on 23 June 2022, Latvia has prioritised support to Ukraine and Moldova for the reform and Euro-integration processes, including public administration development and capacity building, promotion of rule of law and justice, fight against corruption, civil society development and promotion of democratic participation, decentralisation, promotion of gender equality, strengthening the resilience of society to disinformation, media support, cybersecurity, as well as development of entrepreneurship, especially small and medium-sized enterprises.

At the same time, Latvia's priority is to engage in the reconstruction process in Ukraine. Latvia's involvement in the reconstruction of Ukraine is based on the needs of Ukraine, as well as taking into account Latvia's capacities, existing practices and priority areas for development cooperation – good governance, gender equality, education, and economic growth. Latvia has chosen the reconstruction of Chernihiv Oblast as a priority. The objective of the assistance is to provide basic services to the population of the Oblast, to overcome the trauma caused by the war and to promote the socio-economic development of Chernihiv Oblast. Separate documents will be prepared and approved by the Cabinet of Ministers to plan Latvia's future involvement in the reconstruction of Ukraine.

Latvian development cooperation activities, and thus ODA funding, are drawn from activities implemented in bilateral and multilateral formats. The multilateral format mainly includes international contributions to the EU budget, the European Development Fund, as well as contributions to UN agencies and other international institutions, initiatives and trust funds. In these formats, it is important to advocate Latvia's key priority areas and regions and to raise Latvia's profile. However, the bilateral format of Latvia's ODA includes funds earmarked in the Ministry of Foreign Affairs' budget programme 07.00.00 "Development Cooperation Projects and International Assistance"; funding for bilateral development cooperation from other public institutions, ad hoc aid and humanitarian aid.

The activities included in the Plan (of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and line ministries) are structured according to the six action lines of the Guidelines and their objectives:

### 1. Provide support for the sustainable development of priority partner countries and contribute to addressing global challenges:

For the implementation of the measures included in this action line, it is foreseen to allocate most of the funds allocated in the Ministry of Foreign Affairs budget programme 07.00.00 "Development Cooperation Projects and International Assistance" (EUR 1 863 813 annually for 2024–2026) to the implementation of the following activities.

<u>First, to organise grant project tenders:</u> 1) for the implementation of development cooperation projects in support of the EU Eastern Partnership countries and Central Asian countries and other regions (in particular African countries); 2) for the co-financing of development cooperation and global education projects implemented by CSOs which have received funding from other international aid donors; 3) for feasibility study visits by implementers.

Secondly, to implement long-term development cooperation projects in line with the expressed needs of partner countries and Latvian expertise and projects with at least 50% cofinancing from other donors.

2. Strengthen the implementation of Latvian development cooperation priorities within the framework of multilateral cooperation, in particular within the EU, UN, WBG and OECD, thereby promoting the coherence of Latvian Development Cooperation Policy in all formats

In multilateral formats, it is planned to continue to develop inclusive positions on topical development cooperation issues and to strengthen dialogue with the Saeima.

3. Strengthen the institutional framework for the implementation of Latvian development cooperation, the professionalism of policymakers and implementers and the coherence of activities

In line with the Guidelines, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, through this Plan, promotes coherence in Latvian development cooperation activities. One of the most important tasks of this line will be to promote Latvia's involvement in the implementation of large-scale EU and other donor-funded development cooperation projects and the integration of related functions into the Agency's work, enhancing the Agency's capacity and professionalism, as well as the EC accreditation process for full development cooperation agency status (starting in 2023). The Agency will be able to work fully with EU funds in the indirect management of development cooperation funds once it has been assessed by the EC. Indirect management is one of the EC budget implementation methods to which Latvia currently has no access without an EC-accredited body.

Alongside the programming of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs' development cooperation budget, the plan also includes 38 development cooperation measures to be implemented in developing countries by 15 Latvian public administrations. Given the fact that the activities of public administrations represent a significant part of Latvia's bilateral development cooperation funding, it is important to promote the linkage of these activities with the policy planned by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs.

## 4. Strengthen transparency, predictability and compliance of Latvian development cooperation with international reporting standards

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs continues its efforts to strengthen the evaluation system for supported projects, introducing multiannual programming, thereby increasing predictability and flexibility in the implementation of bilateral development cooperation funding, while ensuring the ability to respond quickly and effectively to the changing circumstances of the present times. Latvian support will assess, prevent and manage risks, in particular in the area of corruption, and improve the assessment of partner countries' needs in order to identify priorities transparently and select the most appropriate aid procedures.

## 5. Promote public awareness of sustainable development and development cooperation, participation and support for policy implementation

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs regularly updates and develops up-to-date information on development cooperation on the Ministry's website and continues its dialogue with partners, project implementers and stakeholders.

In addition to the activities of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, the support foreseen in the table 'Allocation of the bilateral development cooperation budget of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs' in Section II, Clause 4.1 of this Plan is earmarked for this purpose in order to ensure public awareness among a wide range of target groups. Given the need to ensure the broad involvement of CSOs, schools, libraries, universities, youth centres and other partners, these activities are planned to be implemented in cooperation with LAPAS, an association of NGOs working in the field of development cooperation and global education, which has extensive experience in raising awareness of development cooperation and implementing projects in developing countries.

It is planned to provide direct funding from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs' development cooperation budget programme from 2024 onwards for the participation of LALRG and LAPAS on CSO platforms of the EU and international organisations, as well as for the participation of LAPAS in forums of international importance.

## 6. Strengthen Latvia's comprehensive and coherent approach to promoting sustainable development worldwide

In planning and implementing development cooperation policy, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs cooperates with the responsible public administration institutions, CSOs and the private sector, strengthening synergies between the approval procedures available for the implementation of development cooperation, foreign and security policy.

The concept of the Plan was endorsed by the Consultative Board for Development Cooperation Policy on 9 November 2023.

#### II. Description of the current situation

The Plan is based on the Guidelines and in accordance with Section <u>6</u>, Paragraph one of the <u>Law on International Assistance</u> and determines the use of development cooperation funding allocated by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs in the 2024–2026 budget, includes descriptions of the measures to be implemented under the measures funded by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and promotes the coherence of development cooperation at a broader level.

With the increase in funding, Latvia has made it a priority to support other regions, particularly in Africa, by contributing to global public goods and addressing global challenges, and in line with Latvia's development cooperation policy commitments to support LDCs as well.

The budget of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs for the implementation of development cooperation for the years 2024–2025 and 2026 foresees EUR 1 863 813 annually. In 2027, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs is expected to need at least the same amount of funding – EUR 1 863 813. At the same time, in view of Latvia's commitment to reach 0.33% of GNI by 2030, it is necessary to increase funding for bilateral development assistance. According to the Guidelines and Cabinet Order No. 173 adopted on 8 April 2020 "On the Conceptual Report "On an increased allocation of funding for development cooperation in 2021–2025", an additional EUR 3 293 619 will be required as a minimum in 2025.

The increase in funding for development cooperation would enhance Latvia's visibility in the world (including by working towards Latvia's candidacy for a non-permanent member of the UN Security Council in the 2025 elections for 2026–2027), bring benefits in bilateral relations and contribute to foreign economic policy, as well as opportunities to improve its development cooperation systems and community capacities. This in turn would allow one to make better use of the expertise and solutions (including technology transfer) available in Latvia to deliver sustainable aid, as well as provide new opportunities for Latvian public institutions, CSOs and the private sector involved in the implementation of development cooperation projects. In addition, bilateral development assistance planning has more scope to promote synergies with security, trade, external economic and migration policies and their instruments.

The funding allocated in 2024 will continue cooperation activities already launched and support new development cooperation initiatives. Strategic development cooperation projects are included in the Plan in accordance with the criteria for direct inclusion in the Plan set out in the Guidelines: 1) projects in line with Latvia's strategic priorities (including foreign policy, security, economy, digitalisation) and geopolitical situation; 2) implementation of trilateral cooperation projects and activities with at least 50% co-financing from other donors, including projects under evaluation; 3) long-term development cooperation projects according to the needs expressed by partner countries and Latvia's expertise.

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs may decide to implement a strategic development cooperation project for the period 2024–2027, which is not included in the Plan, by assessing the current situation.

Strategic development cooperation projects will be contracted on the basis of the Medium-Term Budget Framework Law in force at the time of contracting, providing for an annual evaluation of the progress of project implementation, as well as a requirement for project implementers to provide annual information on the activities planned for the following year and their costs.

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs will be guided by the following principles when assessing the amount of funding available for the current year in the budget programme 07.00.00 "Development Cooperation Projects and International Assistance", changes in which may be affected by various circumstances, in order to ensure the efficient and rational use of the State budget funds:

1. In the event that in the current year it is not possible to implement one of the activities (Activity 1.2–4.2) or less funding is needed for their implementation, there is unused funding from the implementation of these activities or additional funding is reallocated within the budget of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs for the implementation of the development cooperation policy, it will be reallocated in priority order to Activity 1.1 "Grant project tenders in support of partner countries" if the grant projects tender has not been completed or, in accordance with Section 5 of the Law on International Assistance, reallocated to other development cooperation activities by a decision of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs.

Priority activities for the reallocation of funding in the above cases will be selected in accordance with the procedures for the approval of international assistance identified in Section 5 of the Law on International Assistance, as well as those set out in the Guidelines.

- 2. In the event that in the current and subsequent years, the funding in the annual Law on State Budget for the implementation of the development cooperation policy in the budget of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs is increased but does not reach the amount set out in the Guidelines for the respective year, the additional funding will mainly be allocated to Activity 1.1 "Grant project tenders in support of partner countries", as well as other development cooperation activities, in particular Activity 2.2 in the field of digitisation. Contracts with grant project implementers will be based on the Law on Medium-Term Budget Framework in force at the time of contracting.
- 3. In the event that the planned funding for the implementation of the development cooperation policy in the budget of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs is reduced, resulting in the impossibility of implementing all the projects included in the Plan, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs may decide not to implement certain measures, having assessed the amount of available funding and priority areas.

The Plan has been prepared in light of the international, EU and Latvian planning documents described in the Guidelines, including the Latvian National Development Plan for 2021–2027<sup>2</sup>, Agenda 2030<sup>3</sup> and the European Consensus on EU Development<sup>4</sup>.

In implementing the measures set out in the Plan, restrictions may be imposed on the areas and partners of projects to be supported if the situation in a partner country deteriorates or if there are violations of the rule of law, democracy and respect for human rights.
